



Church Finances

How we pay our way

Running the Church in Luxembourg costs around €90,000 a year. On top of this, we give at least another €15,000 to charity.

So, where does this money come from?

Well, we haven't benefited from any legacies, we don't have a portfolio of investments, and we don't receive any grants from the Church of England. Apart from the income from our Church Fair - which all goes to charity - 95% of our income comes from giving by the congregation. Just over a quarter of that comes via the collection plate, Sunday by Sunday. The rest comes from members giving by Standing Order, which is the easiest and most stable way for the congregation to offer its financial support.

The average monthly giving by Standing Order is €90, but everyone is totally free to give what they feel is right, depending on personal circumstances and the degree to which they want to support the work of the Church here in Luxembourg.
