Some practical points

The Date you want

Normally the baptism will take place during the main Sunday service but not every Sunday service is a suitable occasion to include a baptism. Please consult with the clergy or pastoral secretary before making your final arrangements. We will try to enable the baptism to take place on the Sunday you ask for. Sometimes when there are many baptism applications we have a Baptism Sunday when all the baptisms take place together.

Photos and Videos

Friends and family are welcome to video the baptism itself, but for legal reasons they are not allowed to video the whole morning service. Just before or just after the baptism there will always be an opportunity to take photographs, but if you wish to take pictures of the actual baptism please ask the priest or minister who is conducting the service.

Relax - what can go wrong ?

Nothing ever seems to go wrong in baptisms, but getting a baby ready for church can be fraught - don't worry if you are a bit late, we know what it's like. The baptism will come about halfway through the morning service and your seats will be reserved.

Cost

Baptism is free, there is no fee or charge, but donations to the church are always welcome! If you want to make a donation give it to the priest or minister who is conducting the service, or fill out a virement form and put it, in an envelope, in the offering during the service.
