Crèche Report – 2013

We presently have 9 babies, toddlers and young children up to the age of 3 registered as attending Crèche. The register indicates that from this number we have a regular attendance of 6 babies and toddlers. We welcome Mums and Dads that remain in the Crèche until their child is comfortable with staying alone. The Crèche also receives visiting babies and toddlers who are welcome to stay in the Crèche with one parent or grandparent.

During the past year, Crèche volunteers have continued to provide a fundamental service to our families with babies and toddlers. As of March 2014 there were twelve volunteers on the Crèche rota, all of these adult. Although we no longer have any teenage helpers on the rota, we were very grateful to have a couple of former teen volunteers step in on the occasional Sunday to act as a second helper. Out of the twelve full-time adult helpers on the Crèche rota, five are also volunteers for Junior Church.

Although there has been no formal Crèche Co-ordinator during the past 15 months, I assumed the duty of organising the Crèche rota and handled any necessary paperwork for the Crèche file (which was a very light task). All being well, Eyi Geers hopes to resume as Crèche Co-Ordinator once more during the next year.

The Crèche room aims to be open ten minutes before the start of the 11.00 am service on Sundays. Parents and guardians are asked to complete a registration form for their children which should include medical or other special needs of the child that Crèche volunteers should know about.

We should like to thank all those who have served on the Crèche rota in the past year for their valued help.
