

## **The Anglican Church of Luxembourg Young Adults' Group Report – 2013**

The Young Adults' Group (YAG) has been active since 2006. The core activity of the group remains, ensuring a regular presence and meetings in Luxembourg. One of YAG's most important aims is to act as a welcome network for anyone in the demographic arriving in Luxembourg. We consider the 'young adults' tag to be very flexible – our doors are definitely open to anyone who is happy to join us.

The group met regularly in Autumn 2013, but has been less active in 2014 so far. The meetings have been based on the Emmaus course, which is a useful springboard for discussions relating to the church, the Bible and Christian life. It was decided to meet every two weeks and to consider meeting sometimes on Tuesdays, rather than just on Wednesdays to give people with different commitments the chance to attend.

We did 'join up' with the Lent study group again this year, which is a good chance to meet other people within the church; we also had a successful Shrove Tuesday meeting, complete, of course, with pancakes.

We plan to start meeting again in May. The usual meeting place is the home of Paul and Katarina Townend in Merl (details available on the church website), but we may start meeting elsewhere in future, as well.
