

## **The Anglican Church of Luxembourg Crèche AGM Report 2014 - 2015**

*A brief summary of Crèche activities:*

- we presently have 9 babies, toddlers and young children up to the age of 3 registered as attending Crèche.
- the register indicates that from this number we have a regular attendance of 6 babies and toddlers.

During the past year Crèche volunteers have continued to provide a fundamental service to our families with babies and toddlers.

- As of March 2015 there were 7 volunteers on the Crèche rota, all of these adult. We no longer have any teenage helpers on the rota.
- Out of the 7 full-time adult helpers on the Crèche rota, 3 are also volunteers for both Junior Church and on morning tea rota whilst one volunteers solely for Junior Church.

I use this opportunity to thank Jane-Anne Frankel for assuming the duty of organising the Crèche rota and handling any necessary paperwork for the Crèche file whilst I was on maternity and parental leave in late 2013 and early 2014.

- The Crèche room aims to be open ten minutes before the start of the 11.00 am service on Sundays.
- We have had many Sundays in the past two quarters where we had no volunteer to man the Crèche. On these occasions the Crèche room was set-up and toys put out for parents who needed to use the room.
- Parents and guardians are asked to complete a registration form for their children, which should include medical or other special needs of the child that Crèche volunteers should know about.

We would like to thank all those who have served on the Crèche rota in the past year for their valued help.
