Wellsprings report for 2017-2018

The contemplative prayer group *Wellsprings* offers a time to pray and simply be aware of God's presence, in the company of other people, in a relaxed home environment. *Wellsprings* warmly welcomes everyone – often with cake!

Wellsprings has continued to meet fortnightly on Thursday evenings. It enjoys the regular attendance of a core group of about 4-5 people, with a number of others who come when they are in town and available. Amongst the regular attendees are Christians from other churches in Luxembourg.

The sessions focus on Meditation of Scriptures and silent Contemplation. We sometimes also take time for prayerful reflection of the day (called Examen), intercessions, the Lord's Prayer and the Grace. All of this is followed by a time of cake and fellowship. In recent meetings we have started our meeting by singing or listening to a short praise or Taizé song.
