Crèche AGM Report for April 2017 – March 2018

- During the period, April 2017 until March 2018 we had eleven toddlers and young children registered as attending crèche. Five of the eleven attend Crèche regularly.
- When there are no volunteers to run the crèche, the crèche room is set-up and parents/guardians are asked to stay with their children during their visit.
- During the past year Crèche volunteers have continued to provide a fundamental service to our families with babies and toddlers. As of March 2018, there are eight volunteers on the Crèche rota, all adults. One of our longest serving volunteers, Jane-Anne Frankel, withdrew from the rota to better focus on her other duties on the tea rota and assisting with communion. We say a special thank you to her.

- The Crèche room aims to be open ten minutes before the start of the 11.00 am service on Sundays.
- Parents and guardians are asked to complete a registration form for their children, which should include medical or other special needs of the child that Crèche volunteers should know about.
